Note that participants in both the 10<sup>th</sup> ISEM '15-Matsue (Japan) and the 9<sup>th</sup> ISEM '14-New Delhi (India) as well as in the 11<sup>th</sup> ISEM '16-Ho Chi Minh (Vietnam) are qualified to submit their papers if they have not submitted to any other Journals for review.
