We cordially invite you to submit your recent work to Advanced Experimental Mechanics (AEM), which is an official English journal published by the Japanese Society for Experimental Mechanics (JSEM) that publishes papers annually (or every August) in all areas of experimentation including its theoretical and computational analysis.

All papers are published freely on-line (<https://www.jstage.jst.go.jp/browse/aem/>) through the J-STAGE (online platform for Japanese academic journals) developed and managed by The Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST). Furthermore, the accepted papers after peer reviews are early released on the J-STAGE sequentially before the formal publication of AEM.

Note 3: if your manuscript is submitted before the above dead line, your paper will be reviewed sequentially and then accepted paper will be early released on the J-STAGE sequentially before the formal publication of AEM (Vol.10).

Note 4: if your manuscript submitted after the above dead line is accepted, your paper will be published in the next AEM (Vol.11); however, your paper will be early released on the J-STAGE sequentially before the formal publication of AEM (Vol.11).
